**ALL STUDENTS MUST ATTEND THE THURSDAY DRESS REHEARSAL TO BE IN THE PERFORMANCE – NO EXCEPTIONS. All class fees and costumes fees must be paid by April 27 to receive your costumes.**

### COSTUMES:

All ballet students must have pink ballet slippers, pink tights, unless other tights come with your costume. Jazz students must have black jazz shoes. All bought costumes belong to you after the performance, some hats and props are property of Footlight Dance.

**All fees must be paid in full, by April 27 or students may not receive their costumes with their classmates. No dancer can participate in the performance if fees are not paid in full.**

**Pink tights and ballet slippers are available at the CC studio (limited supply) or you can go to Boise or online [discountdance.com](http://discountdance.com). Don't wait for the last moment to get hair and make-up needs – PLAN AHEAD!**

### HAIR:

Each teacher will decide what hair will look like. Ballet will have their hair in a bun, braids or the like if they have long hair. Short hair must be pulled out of the eyes and “glued” back with setting gel. Please no long bangs in the eyes. Use a hair net on buns so the hair stays in place. Provide your own bobby pins, rubber bands, hair spray, etc. Jazz & tap students – hair out of your face, barrettes, ponytails, braids. PLEASE COME WITH YOUR HAIR DONE.

### JEWELRY:

ABSOLUTELY NO JEWELRY, including earrings, rings, watches, bracelets. Any jewelry will be asked to remove, so leave them at home. Jewelry reflects on the stage in the lights, that is why we do not wear it. (if you have just had your ears pierced, must leave earrings in, please let us know)

### MAKE-UP:

Stage make-up - blush/rouge, red lipstick, mascara (except young ones), eye shadow (no greens) lt. browns and beige best, foundation for older dancers. NO NAIL POLISH or body painting please. Some cats will have whiskers painted on this year.
